

IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND HELPFUL HINTS FOR EASY RECYCLING

RECEPTACLES: Containers for trash must be no more than **32 gallon capacity** weighing no more than 50 lbs when filled. The containers shall be placed no more than 5' away from the property curbline for pick up. **THE LIDS MAY NOT BE ATTACHED OR TIED TO THE TRASH OR RECYCLING CANS. YOU MAY TIE THE LIDS TO BINS/CORRALS ONLY.** Containers that are stored under porches or other parts of the dwelling will NOT be emptied. Commercial only up to 6 containers each.

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING: All mandatory recyclable items including: mixed paper, corrugated cardboard, brown paper bags, newspaper, magazines, commingled bottles, cans, and plastic containers (with a neck smaller than the base) may be placed loose in the same receptacle at the curb. **DO NOT PLACE RECYCLING IN PLASTIC BAGS!**

PLASTIC BAGS, PLASTIC FILM & OUTER WRAPS MAY BE RECYCLED AT GROCERY STORES

BRUSH: All brush (i.e. tree limbs, branches) are recyclable and **MUST be tied in 4' bundles** weighing no more than 40 pounds. Diameter of limbs should be no more than 3-1/2". Brush should not be placed onto dunes. You may also drop off BRUSH to the Public Works Garage. **UNTIED BRUSH WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.** Call 609-361-6676 by noon on Tuesday for Wednesday pick-up.

BULK TRASH: Anything other than household garbage (furniture and bedding, etc.) will be picked up at the property curbside by the trash and recycling contractor NOT the Township. Please refer to your Section Guide to determine which day is your Trash day. **TOILET TANKS** must be separate from the base. **WOOD** must be cut into 4' lengths and tied together. **NAILS** must be removed or nailed down. **CARPET** must be cut into 4' lengths and tied in bundles weighing no more than 40 lbs. Only a "reasonable" amount of bulk trash will be picked up.

Construction debris, concrete, brick, asbestos and anything considered hazardous WILL NOT BE PICKED UP. If there is a building permit, the homeowner is responsible for disposal of ALL debris due to construction.

CLIPPINGS: Chips, pine needles, cones, grass and weeds are to be placed in plastic bags and put out along with your household trash.

E-WASTE: PICK UP ONLY for Long Beach Township residents. We will no longer be accepting electronic waste at the recycling drop-off center. Residents and homeowners can still call or email thompson@longbeachtownship.com for the following materials only: Computers, TV's, Monitors, and Laptops, Printers/Fax machines. Homeowners and residents can also drop off electronics at the Southern Ocean County Facility in Manahawkin..

APPLIANCES/SCRAP METAL: These items will be picked up by the Township. For pickup: email thompson@longbeachtownship.com or call 609-361-6676. You may leave the information by telling us your name, address, phone number and tell us what item we will be taking. **WE CANNOT TAKE PROPANE TANKS OR PARTIALLY FULL OR EMPTY PAINT CANS** and you may not put these at the curb for any reason.

BATTERIES: Recycle rechargeable batteries. A list of drop off locations is available at the municipal building and on the website. Button batteries can only be recycled at the Southern Ocean County Recycling Center, 379 Haywood Road, Manahawkin, 609-978-0913. Hours of operation for the summer are Monday through Saturday 7:30am to 3:00pm.

PLEASE NOTE!!

All trash must be put in a covered container with a lid - **DO NOT** place plastic trash bags, plastic shopping bags or trash with recyclables at curbside.

RECYCLABLES IN PLASTIC BAGS OR CONTAINING PLASTIC FILM OR OUTER WRAP WILL NOT BE PICKED UP!

SINGLE STREAM "RECYCLING" must be in a covered container marked specifically. **DO NOT PUT RECYCLABLES IN PLASTIC BAGS AND PLEASE DO NOT TIE NEWSPAPERS.**

RECYCLABLES IN PLASTIC BAGS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.
