ORDINANCES & PUBLIC HEARINGS

1. Second Reading Ordinance 20-24: AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A DEED OF EASEMENT LOCATED ON BLOCK 4.35, LOT 6, ON THE TAX MAP OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LONG BEACH TO THE COUNTY OF OCEAN

Passed on first reading at a regular meeting held on September 14, 2020 and advertised in the BEACH HAVEN TIMES issue of September 17. 2020.

WHEREAS, the Township of Long Beach ("Township") owns a certain property located at Block 4.35, Lot 6, on the Tax Map of the Township of Long Beach ("Property"); and

WHEREAS, the County of Ocean ("County") has requested to acquire an easement on the Property to construct, operate, and maintain traffic signal utilities at the intersection abutting the Property in order to protect the public health, welfare, and safety; and

WHEREAS, Township deems it appropriate, necessary, and proper for the good government, order, the protection of persons and property, and for the preservation of the public health, welfare, and safety of Township and its inhabitants to convey the proposed Deed of Easement negotiated between County and Township; and

WHEREAS, Township's engineer has reviewed the legal description and survey as to the location of the easement for the construction of the traffic signal utilities and has advised that said legal description and survey plot on the Property as set forth in the Deed of Easement; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Deed of Easement and Survey are attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, Township's attorney has reviewed and approved the proposed form of Deed of Easement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to, inter alia, N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13, Township is required to authorize the convey the easement in its interest in the Property to County by

WHEREAS, Township intends to authorize the execution of the Deed of Easement, and, therefore, convey the easement on the Property to County pursuant to and in accordance with the foregoing bases and the express representations made by County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of Township of Long Beach, Ocean County, State of New Jersey, in accordance with the aforesaid Recitals, which are incorporated herein by reference as if set forth fully herein, that the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Deed of Easement in the identical form proposed by County.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of this Ordinance is to authorize the execution of the Deed of Easement as proposed by County of Ocean, which shall convey an easement in certain property located at Block 4.35, Lot 6, on the Tax Map of Township of Long Beach, in order for the County of Ocean to construct, operate, and maintain traffic signal utilities at the intersection abutting the property.

§1. Authorization and Terms

The Mayor and Municipal Clerk of Township of Long Beach are hereby authorized to execute the proposed Deed of Easement (Exhibit A), which shall convey an easement in the Property for the aforesaid purposes.

All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

§3. Severability.

If any word, phrase, clause, section, or provision of this ordinance shall be found by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, illegal or unconstitutional, such word, phrase, clause, section, or provision shall be severable from the balance of the ordinance and the remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Hypochlorite Feed System and Related Water Supply Service Equipment Including Services for the Holgate

Water Treatment Plant; \$24,700

WHEREAS, the Township of Long Beach ("Township") requires a Calcium Hypochlorite Fee System at the Holgate water treatment plant for the continued provision of water supply services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(gg), the Township's purchase of goods and services for the provision of water supply services and any component part thereof is exempt from the bidding requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law; and

WHEREAS, G.P. Jager, Inc., is able to provide the required goods, a Lonza Constant-Chlor Reeder Model MC4-50 Calcium Hypochlorite Feed System a Watson Marlow Qdos 30 Universal Plus Peristaltic Metering Pump, a Depolox 400M Analyzer, and services, shipping and startup and training, for Twenty-Four Thousand and Seven Hundred Dollars (\$24,700.00), as per Quotation No. 24627B dated 9/29/2020; and

WHEREAS, G.P. Jager, Inc., has completed the required Pay-to-Play Law forms and the Township has complied with the Pay-to-Play Law requirements set forth in N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5 in the award of this contract pursuant to the non-fair and open provisions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 18-0702.15, the Township of Long Beach received from Island's End, LLC., Check No. 006292 from Unity Bank, dated June 22, 2018 in the amount of Sixty-Seven Thousand Fifty-Six Dollars (\$67,056.00), as the required cash portion of the Performance Bond for Major Sub-division #LUB-32-17, Block 1.13, Lots 4, 21-25, Block 1.16, Lots 2-7, 12, 14-18, Block 1.19, Lots 6-9, 11-19; and

WHEREAS, the Performance Guarantee was submitted at that time in the form of a Rider and Performance Surety Bond in the amount of Six Hundred Three Thousand Five Hundred Four Dollars (\$603,504.00); and

WHEREAS, the property was inspected on May 7, 2020 by the Municipal Engineer who determined that certain work items had been completed and recommended a reduction in the Performance Bond cash required to Twenty-Three Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$23,100.00) and Bond required to Two Hundred Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$207,900.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Commissioners approves the reduction of the Performance Bond and a refund in the amount of Forty-Three Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars (\$43,956.00) be released, accepts a new Performance Guarantee Bond in the amount of Two Hundred Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$207,900.00) and return the old Rider and Performance Bond as recommended and certified by the Municipal Engineer.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 5-4 requires the governing body of every local unit to have made an annual audit of its books, accounts and financial transactions, and

WHEREAS, the Annual Report of Audit for the year 2019 has been filed by a Registered Municipal Accountant with the Municipal Clerk pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 5-6, and a copy has been received by each member of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, R.S. 52:27BB-34 authorizes the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey to prescribe reports pertaining to the local fiscal affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Local Finance Board has promulgated N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5, a regulation requiring that the governing body of each municipality shall, by resolution, certify to the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey that all members of the governing body have reviewed, at a minimum, the sections of the annual audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the members of the governing body have personally reviewed, at a minimum, the Annual Report of Audit, and specifically the sections of the Annual Audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations, as evidenced by the group affidavit form of the governing body attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, such resolution of certification shall be adopted by the Governing Body no later than forty-five days after the receipt of the annual audit, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5; and

WHEREAS, all members of the governing body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board; and

WHEREAS, failure to comply with the regulations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the local governing body to the penalty provisions of <u>R.S.</u> 52:27BB-52, to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52: A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Long Beach, hereby states that it has complied with <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 5:30-6.5 and does hereby submit a certified copy of this resolution and the required affidavit to said Board to show evidence of said compliance.
