

ORDINANCE 22-01C

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LONG BEACH, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, (1997)" AS THE SAME IN CHAPTER 64, WHICH PERTAINS TO BUILDING CONSTRUCTION

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

This Ordinance amends Chapter 64 to repeal certain regulations relating to bulkhead construction requirements for lagoon and bayside properties as a condition of certificates of occupancy.

SECTION I

§64-13A is hereby deleted and B and C are hereby redesignated as A and B, respectively.

SECTION II

All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION III

If any word, phrase, clause, section, or provision of this ordinance shall be found by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, illegal, or unconstitutional, such word, phrase, clause, section, or provision shall be severable from the balance of the ordinance and the remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


Effective date.
