Dear Homeowner:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), along with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), is now requiring drinking water service providers to update their records to include the pipe material being used to provide water from the curb into your home or business. This can be copper, galvanized or poly (plastic) pipe.

In reviewing Long Beach Township's records, we do not have anything on file regarding the type of pipe material that was used for your water service. If you know the type of pipe material you have coming into your home or business from the curb, you can either call our office or email us this information (please see contact info below). If you are unsure, we can make an appointment with you to have one of our employees come out and look at the pipe that enters your residence.

You can contact the Long Beach Township Water and Sewer Department at 609-492-6314, with your information or any concerns that you may have, or to set up an appointment for us to come out and check the piping for you. There is, of course no charge to you. You can email your information to
